**We invite you again to be screened for colon cancer free of charge.** The stool test detects blood in the stool. This may indicate that you have polyps or colon cancer without noticing it yourself. You decide for yourself whether to take part.

Every year, more than 360,000 men and women aged 50 to 74 in Flanders take part in the screening.

**Are you in?** We have not received any sample from you. That is why we offer you once again the opportunity to participate. The screening is free of charge.

**Have you already sent in a sample?** Then please ignore this letter.

Please use the participation form on the reverse of this letter. The leaflet and collection kit with the user instructions for the stool test were included with the previous invitation.
